#### August 21



In the evening we explored the Gauja River Valley (452 km long and 81 meters deep) by driving through the Sigulda city. Sigulda has the Green City area, a really lush environment. Along the way we explored many different castles from the bus and saw the Green Way. There was a basket lift across the river and there was also a bungee jumping opportunity in the area.

Within the area of the National Park was the Hotel Zeit which was a fine and personal hotel, with 9 different rooms, each room was decorated differently: the dreamer's room, the worker's (quite similar as wooden workers dwelling area, builded in 1920's in Helsinki) and the gardener's room



and the guests had a common small kitchen. The building was an old helmet factory and in the vicinity was a workers' residence, which was circled by bus. The hotel had a Seminar and Concert Hall, a very versatile building. There is art exhibition and a playgroud for children. The hotel is run by three couples and they started two years ago with a café, expanded the network into a park and then built hotel rooms. Entrepreneurs wanted to expand the company. We had a lovely dinner in Cafe Zeit outside on the terrace. Next to terrace was a climbing park and some participants took a closer look at it.



### August 23

On Friday we travelled to Limbaži county to visit Tourist information center. We got nice presentation of Old Fire Depot and history of Latvia machinery.



Next we visited to Katvari Lake Park, Mini Zoo where lovely entrepreneur told us about her tourism business and horse breeding.





Bussines Support center (and library) we got presentation about the center's idea, history and possibilities for entrepreneurs of Aloja area. Lake near Business center has floating islands and we saw a film about the magical movement.



The center has also an intresting machine, which performed land shapes and variations of altitude

with sand and colours.
